School Lunch: Lunch fees have been displayed separately for transparency, however will **not** be optional and therefore included in the fees for all students.

Swimming: Swimming fee Kshs. 15,250/- per swimming term.

Adult friend morning snack & lunch : Caregivers or nannies morning snack, tea and lunch will be charged at Kshs. 450/- per day or Kshs. 21,000/- per term.

Sibling discount: 10% Sibling discount available for second child onwards.

Fees are inclusive of: Class materials and activities (unless specified otherwise)

Fees are exclusive of:

- Individual student stationery kit for primary which can be purchased by parents through the school which will cost approximately **Kshs. 7,000 8,000/-** per term.
- Extra costs of field trips and any special activities.

For new students:

- A non-refundable application fee of Kshs. 5,000/- is payable for all classes.
- A non-refundable admission fee of Kshs. 7,000/- (Kshs 12,000/- for primary is payable).
- Each child admitted to the school will pay a fully refundable "caution" fee of **Kshs. 20,000** for kindergarten or for primary it will be **Kshs. 50,000/-**. It is fully refundable as long as a full notice period of one term is given.

Trial day arrangement: New families are welcome to visit the school for a 3 day trial. If you do not wish to enrol after the trial, you will not be charged. If you do enrol after the trial, the trial days are not deducted from the invoice.

Fee Refund or waiver: There shall be no waiver or refund of school fees for any reasons whatsoever including but not limited to extended vacations, late reporting, late admission, natural disaster, withdrawal or illness, of the learner from the school.

Withdrawal of child from school: Please note, if you wish to withdraw your child from Mount Kenya Waldorf School, a full term's written notice is required. Failure to provide notice will result in being charged for the upcoming term, regardless of attendance.

Bursary:

We are also proud of our bursary scheme which strives to promote wider access to our school for children from a variety of backgrounds. If
interested, please email or contact the school for more details. Please note access to a bursary is based on the school's absolute discretion.
Provision of proof of income and bank statements for six months will be required. As well as a contractual commitment to supporting the school
through other means (such as volunteering, teaching, etc.) will be required in lieu of any fee deduction.
